

May 18th Update:

At Sharp Vision and Eye Doc, we know the importance of caring for our patients and providing safe and effective care. For the past several weeks, we have been limiting our patient visits and implementing safety protocols.

The March CDC recommendation to postpone routine eye care is no longer in effect. This means that we can now see patients without urgent/ emergent issues. We will continue to monitor CDC guidance as we expand our schedule to ensure safety for our patients and staff.

For patients being seen in our clinic, the CDC is now recommending that all staff, patients, and visitors cover their faces in health care facilities. To help reduce the spread of COVID-19, we are asking patients to bring and wear a face covering (such as protective mask or cloth covering) to any upcoming appointments. Masks or cloth coverings must be worn over your mouth and nose for the duration of your appointment. Members of your care team will also wear masks to help reduce the spread of COVID-19. If you do not have access to a face covering, you can use a scarf or bandana.

We will take temperature of all our team members each day. On the day of your appointment, we will also take your temperature when you arrive. If it is more than 100.4 F, you must reschedule your appointment.

We continue to ask that you do not bring anyone with you to your appointment, with the exceptions of a guardian with a child and assistance with mobility. We have hand sanitizer available to use in the office as needed. Our waiting room will no longer offers magazines or children's toys, since those items are difficult to clean and disinfect.

Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients. This might mean that you are offered fewer options for scheduling your appointment. We will schedule extra time between patients to reduce waiting times for you, as well as to reduce the number of patients in the reception area at any one time. Please call ahead if you need to visit an office to purchase/ pick-up glasses or contacts. We look forward to seeing you soon!
